

Big Springs Village Board of Trustees
Regular Meeting Minutes
Tuesday, December 2, 2025

The Village of Big Springs Board of Trustees met on December 2, 2025, at 7:00 PM in the Village Office meeting room. Notice of the meeting was posted at the Big Springs Post Office, Community First Bank, Village Office in accordance with procedure. The meeting adhered to the Open Meetings Act, which was displayed in the room. The agenda was kept current and available for public inspection at the Village Office and on the website. Advance notice and the agenda were provided to board members, with acknowledgments attached to these minutes. The meeting was recorded and open to the public.

Roll Call: Present Trustees: Everitt, Huff, Payne, and DeCoste. Absent Trustees: Thompson. Others present: Village Clerk/Treasurer Tamera Loomis, Village Maintenance Supt. Curtis Brown, Librarians Connie Shaw and Janie Jimenez, and Village Attorney Josh Wendell.

Chairman Huff called the meeting to order.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Advisory: Chairman Huff announced that a copy of the Nebraska Open Meeting Law Poster is posted on the north wall of the meeting room, accessible to the public.

Approval of Minutes: Huff moved, and Payne seconded, to approve the minutes from the November 4 Regular Meeting and the November 11 Special Meeting. Yea: Everitt, DeCoste, Payne, and Huff. Motion passed.

Reorganization – CY2026 Appointed Officials: Chairman Huff moved to appoint Josh Wendell as Village Attorney, seconded by DeCoste, and the motion passed with Payne, Everitt, Huff, and DeCoste voting Yea. Huff then moved, seconded by Everitt, regarding the Village Clerk/Treasurer appointment; the Board voted not to reappoint Tamera Loomis, with Everitt, Huff, and DeCoste voting Yea and Payne voting Nay. Motion passed. Huff also moved to appoint Tom Werblow as Village Engineer and Street Superintendent, seconded by Everitt, and the motion passed with DeCoste, Huff, Thompson, and Payne voting Yea.

Brief department reports were presented.

Huff moved to approve \$10,273.75 Utility Bond Payments from the Utility Bond Reserve Fund. Everitt seconded. Yea: DeCoste, Payne, Everitt, and Huff. Motion passed.

Everitt moved to approve contribution of a Family Swimming Pool Pass for Santa Drawing on December 6, 2025. Payne seconded. Yea: Everitt, Huff, DeCoste, and Payne. Motion passed.

Huff moved to approve the claims. Everitt seconded. Yea: Payne, Everitt, DeCoste, Huff. Motion passed.
